CVNA Action Plan 2018-2019

- **Ongoing Project:** Remain current and informed on all aspects of Portland Comprehensive Plan, Transportation Plan and Infill project for effects on Collins View neighborhood's livability. Partners with City of Portland, Land Use, Transportation, PP&R Departments. Assigned to CVNA Land Use, Transportation, Parks Committees.
- **Ongoing Project:** Remain current and involved on all aspects of River View Natural Area, including traffic impacts and user/visitor compliance issues. Partners with Friends of RVNA, PP&R, BES, Metro, Intertwine, Watershed. Assigned to CVNA Parks Committee and CVNA Watershed Committee
- **Ongoing Project:** Work to get a crosswalk and warning light at the intersection of Primrose and Terwilliger Blvd. Partners with PBOT and SWNI Transportation Committee; assigned to CVNA Transportation Committee. (Update 2018): Still in evaluation and needs a major prodding and push from SWNI transportation committee and that is where it is moving to (date?).
- **Ongoing Project:** work on failed intersection of Second Ave. and Terwilliger Blvd. Partners with PBOT and SWNI Transportation Committee; assigned to CVNA Transportation Committee. (Update 2018): The Second Ave. issue is not really going anywhere in the near future. A 'roundabout' is not feasible in its current dependence on the 'back' and 'front' intersections. Lake Oswego traffic is a factor that no one has any ready answer to. The only other possible solution is major relocating of the traffic signals and the city is in denial to even study it.
- **Ongoing Project:** Work on obtaining a bus station at the intersection of Primrose and Terwilliger Blvd. Partners with PBOT, TriMet and SWNI Transportation Committee; assigned to CVNA Transportation Committee. (Update 2018): The bus station on Primrose is still in the evaluation stage and it will be on both sides of Terwilliger.
- **(New 2018) Project:** A project to recruit, enlist, and document "Affiliated Volunteers" to the Collins View NET team. The "Affiliated Volunteer" would assist trained NET team members in an emergency, but would not go through NET training. Partners with PBEM, Riverdale/Tryon NET Consortium, and Collins View NET. Assigned to CVNA NET Committee.

- **Accomplished: (& Ongoing) Project:** Emergency Preparedness and NET training for all neighbors available in SW Portland. A number of fast track, concentrated NET training sessions were held and fully attended throughout Portland in 2017. Partners with PBEM, Riverdale/Tryon NET Consortium, and Collins View NET. Assigned to CVNA NET Committee.
- **Accomplished Stormwater Runoff Project:** Workshop and work party led by Tryon Creek Watershed Council Terri Preeg-Riggsby; visited sites and CV neighbors affected by the winter stormwater runoff; trees planted to provide canopy and avert soil erosion; sponsored Tryon Creek Watershed speaker at CVNA's October 2017 "First Wednesday Event." Assigned to CVNA Watershed-Brendan McGillicuddy, and Outreach-Fran Laird; partnered with Collins View Neighbors, Watershed Council, City of Portland, PBOT (etc.).
