Katy wants neighborhood groups to reinstate "Polluter Pays" tax at City Council meet wed (10th of Mar). So far 10 of 70 polluters have stepped forward to take responsibility. - many polluting organizations no longer in business. The Superfund tax was not renewed in 1996.
